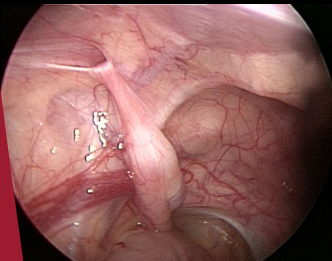

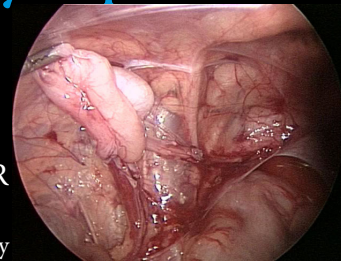

This symposium will include interactive discussions, led by international leaders in the field addressing the evaluation and treatment of the most common pediatric testicular disorders, a live case demonstration of a laparoscopic inguinal hernia repair, and debates on pediatric testicular controversies. Participants will have the opportunity throughout the symposium to discuss these issues and their questions with the faculty.
